Gifted and Talented Education Program Multiple Measures for Identification

AESD GATE Criteria

Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (NNAT®) is the national test criteria for GATE identification. The NNAT is considered to be the gold standard for unbiased scoring regardless of each student's primary language, socioeconomic status, educational history or color/vision impairment.

- ☐ This is because the test includes minimal use of language and written directions to avoid relying on a child's reading, writing or language skills. Additionally, only two colors (blue and yellow) are shown.
- ☐ The NNAT-3 test takes about 30 minutes and includes 48 questions broken down into these four unique subtest types:
- 1. Pattern completion Students must perceive a pattern within a larger design from which a section has been removed and then identify the correct missing piece (often resembles a jigsaw puzzle).
- 2. Reasoning by analogy Students use visual-spatial reasoning abilities to discern logical relationships between various geometric shapes and figures (e.g., large triangle to small triangle)
- 3. Serial reasoning Students must recognize sequences created by shapes and figures that change visually to form logical patterns.(e.g. student identifies the relationship between two images shown in the top row, the same rule applies to images shown in subsequent rows)
- 4. Spatial visualization Students must determine how two or more designs would look when they're combined (and it some cases, rotated).

All students in grade 2 are tested. Students in grade 3 - 8 are tested if recommended by teachers.
