## **CSEA NO-COST BACHELOR'S DEGREE COMPLETION PROGRAM**

### **Complete your Bachelor's Degree online**

CSEA offers the chance to complete a bachelor's degree online from accredited university partners at no-cost.

### **Earn your Teaching Credential**

There is an option to earn your teaching credential at no-cost as part of the Bachelor of Science in Education degree program.

### **What are the requirements?**

Applicants must have an Associate degree or at least 60 transferable credits, and a minimum cumulative 2.2 GPA

### **How does the financial side work?**

The benefit is a "last-dollar scholarship", or grant, that fills the gap between any federal, state or employer education grants you receive and the cost of tuition, fees and e-books. Every applicant is required to complete the FAFSA in order to determine the amount of the "last-dollar scholarship". Even if the applicant does not qualify for federal or other grants, they will still be eligible for this scholarship benefit.

### **What can you study?**

Bachelor's degrees are currently offered in Education, Management/Leadership, Criminal Justice, and Liberal Arts/Social Science.
